Q3 If the election for US Senate were held today, would you vote for Republican Dean Heller or his Democratic opponent?

Dean Heller 31%

Q4 As you may have already heard, the U. S. Senate is considering a new health care law. Do you approve or disapprove of the Senate Republicans' health care repeal and replace plan that is currently being debated?

Q15 If you are 18-45 years old, press 1. If 46-65, press 2. If older than 65, press 3.

<i>18 to 45</i>	32%
